Who can apply:

1. Students in Grade school or High school.
2. Children of member of Gujarati Samaj of Greater Kansas city

Candidate's eligibility for scholarship:

Following requirements must be met to apply for Samaj's monetary scholarship.

1. Candidate (or their parents) must be a LIFE member of the Samaj OR Candidate (or their parents) must be a paid member of the Samaj for current year and previous TWO years.
2. Scholarship form must be filled out by candidate.
3. Candidate must be present to receive award at ceremony unless prior approval of scholarship committee.
4. All information on the form must be substantiated with a copy of the original document.
5. Facts not supported by the copy of the original document must be verifiable by committee. Candidate must provide contact name and phone number to the committee for the claimed fact in the form.
6. Incomplete and non verifiable information will be discarded by the committee.
7. Currently only Grade 5 thru 12 Grade may apply for the Samaj scholarship.
8. Candidate may be required to supply at least one recommendation letter if requested by scholarship committee.
9. Scholarship committee may ask students of grade 10 through 12 to appear for personal interview.

Time Requirement:

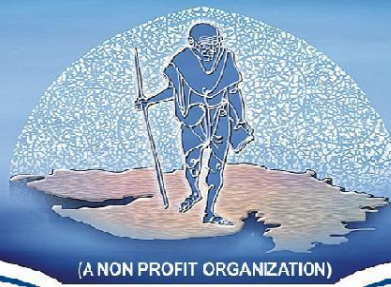
Scholarship award form and all required documents supporting the facts are due by July 31st. Late submission of the application or any requested document will not be entertained.
